It is also important to note that some doctors recommend only the open approach because of the greater cost associated with laparoscopic repair. Others recommend the open approach for unilateral hernias and the laparoscopic approach for bilateral hernias. These surgeons reason that the pain of having two open hernia repairs at the same time balances the difference in cost.

Inguinal Hernia: Open Surgery vs. Laparoscopy

In addition, special surgical equipment is required for laparoscopic procedures. These factors can cause laparoscopic hernia repair to be more expensive than open hernia repair surgery. Laparoscopic hernia repair surgery is associated with less blood loss during surgery.

Open vs. laparoscopic hernia repair surgery: What do you ...

In most cases, the open approach is the best and safest way to repair an incisional hernia. However, there are situations in which patients may benefit from the laparoscopic approach. Thus, incisional hernias are not like inguinal hernias where advantages are present for most patients with the laparoscopic approach.

Open Hernia Surgery vs. Laparoscopy Patient Guide

In our study, laparoscopic incisional hernia repair was not associated with less postoperative pain and nausea compared with open incisional hernia repair. The operative time was significantly longer for laparoscopic repair. Also, perioperative complications were significantly higher in the laparoscopic group.

Laparoscopic vs Open Incisional Hernia Repair: A ...

The hernia is repaired (with suturing or placing a synthetic mesh over the hernia in one of the layers of the abdominal wall) using either open surgery or minimal access laparoscopy. The most common laparoscopic techniques for inguinal hernia repair are transabdominal preperitoneal (TAPP) repair and totally extraperitoneal (TEP) repair.

Background: Inguinal hernia repair is one of the more common procedures performed in the United States. The optimal surgical approach, however, remains controversial. We aimed to compare the postoperative outcomes and costs between laparoscopic and open inpatient inguinal hernia repairs in a national cohort.

The most common method used for hernia surgery is the open repair, which has been used for centuries to repair hernias. The other technique used is the laparoscopic method, which was only introduced about 25 years ago but many surgeons are now successfully using this method to repair hernias.

Hernia Surgery Options: Laparoscopy Versus Open Hernia Repair

Open repair via the Lichenstein method with mesh. Laparoscopic repairs by either a trans abdominal preperitoneal approach or by a totally extraperitoneal approach with mesh. Standardized post-operative instructions (pain limited activity) Bilateral hernias repaired simultaneously with initial site chosen randomly.

Open Mesh versus Laparoscopic Mesh Repair of Inguinal ...

An inguinal hernia repair can be carried out as either open surgery or laparoscopic (or keyhole) surgery. The hospital will send you instructions about when you need to stop eating and drinking before the operation. The operation usually takes about 30 to 45 minutes to complete and you'll usually be able to go home on the same day.

Results of Laparoscopic Versus Open Abdominal and ...

For the repair of inguinal hernia, some surgeons favor the laparoscopic approach, while others recommend open repair. While open repair can result in more scar tissue and carries higher risk of testicular and nerve injury, it is much cheaper and has a shorter surgical learning curve compared to laparoscopic repair (6).

Laparoscopic versus open mesh repair for the treatment of ...

Conclusions: Laparoscopic incisional hernia repair shows, in some (randomized) studies as well as a large number of retrospective analyses and in case control studies, superiority compared to conventional hernia repair. Long-term results with a high level of evidence are not available.

Open versus laparoscopic incisional hernia repair ...

A few studies comparing laparoscopic and open techniques have reported that open repair with mesh is the optimal operation for unilateral primary hernia. The aim of this study is to compare the outcomes of laparoscopic transabdominal preperitoneal repair (TAPP) versus open mesh plug repair (MP) for bilateral primary inguinal hernia.

Traditionally, an open surgical approach has been utilized; however, laparoscopic repair has been gaining favour within the surgical community. We aimed to determine whether open or laparoscopic hernia repair is optimal for pediatric patients by comparing recurrence rates and other outcomes.

Laparoscopic versus open inguinal hernia repair in ...

This study compares two surgical methods that approach primary inguinal hernias from the preperitoneal space: an open preperitoneal mesh repair (Open) and a laparoscopic (TEP) repair with respect to complications, recurrences and the learning curve of each technique.

Apples to Apples: A Comparison of Laparoscopic versus Open ...

Note - If a hernia is particularly large or has been present for a long period of time, an open procedure may be recommended over the laparoscopic option. Also, where deemed necessary, a surgeon will occasionally need to convert a laparoscopic procedure to an open procedure, often to minimise the possibility of tissue damage or bleeding.
